We would like to invite you to attend FAFSA FRENZY at the high school on October 9th from 3:30 to 6:30 to file your senior's FAFSA. All students must file a FAFSA if they plan to attend college or go to a technical school.

Documents needed to file the FAFSA:

1. **FSA ID: (Student and Parent)**. Students have created their FSA ID's at school. Parents you must create your FSA ID before you attend our FAFSA Frenzy. This is the link to create the parent FSA ID- <https://fsaid.ed.gov/>

2. **2016 Tax Returns (Parent and student if they worked)**

3. **2016 W2's**

4. **Social Security Number or Alien Registration Number (Parent and Student)**
