Duties and Responsibilities

- Primary responsibility is to provide speech & language therapy services for qualified students in grades K-12
- Must serve as a member of the IEP teams of each student served
- Maintain documentation of provision of services as related to IEPs
- Maintain compliance in all areas of ADE required documentation of the special education process
- Preferred knowledge of the Medicaid billing process
- Preferred skills & knowledge to serve as Special Education Designee as needed
- Provide Response to Intervention (RTI) services to identified students from regular classrooms to include students who are English Language Learners
- Serves as ELL coordinator
- Perform other duties as assigned

- Must meet AR licensure requirements
